Police Activity Summary (patrol beats 54 and 68):

Country Club to Glen Flora; Green Bay Rd. to Northwestern Ave. 419 police calls for service were generated during the first half of 2017. 20 of those calls were for actual crimes.

Police Activity Summary (patrol beat 82):

Glen Flora to Rt. 132; Green Bay Rd. to Northwestern Ave. 1,066 police calls for service were generated during the first half of 2017. 55 of those calls were for actual crimes.

Police Activity Summary (patrol beat 66):

Deer Creek Condos, 168 police calls for service were generated during the first half of 2017. 8 of those calls were for actual crimes.
