## 3. Public Hearing: United Growth Properties

(United Growth Properties are requesting a petition for an amendment to the existing Grand Hunt Center Planned Unit Development (PUD) (Ord. Number 92-128) to allow: (i) an additional outlot along Grand Avenue; (ii) reducing the parking requirement for Home Depot to one (1) space per 300 sq. ft. of floor area; and (iii) such other relief as may be necessary to accomplish the applicant's development plan. The subject property is the Grand Hunt Shopping Center, located at the southwest corner of Grand Avenue and Hunt Club Road.)

#### 4. Final Subdivision Plat: United Growth at Grand Hunt Center

(United Growth Properties are requesting Final subdivision plat approval to create a .79-acre outlot from the overall 10.5 acre Home Deport parcel located along Grand Avenue just west of the Uno Pizzeria. The property is zoned C/B-2-PUD, Community Business District as a Planned Unit Development.)

# 5. Public Hearing: Preliminary PUD for Duke Realty Limited Partnership

(Duke Realty Limited Partnership, is seeking approval of the following: (i) rezoning of approximately 12 acres, from the C/S-2, Automobile Supported Business District, and R-2, Single-Family Residence District, to the C/O-2, Office and Research District; (ii) a special use permit for a planned unit development (PUD) with Preliminary PUD Plat approval on approximately 38 acres. The subject property is generally located at the northeast corner of Route 120 and Route 21.)
