4. Clarification of Final PUD Plat Plans for Great Lakes Credit Union

(Great Lakes Credit Union is currently under construction at the southeast corner of Grand Avenue and Almond Road on property zoned C/B-2 PUD. Final PUD Plat approval was given in May of this year. At the time Final PUD Plat approval was given, specific information regarding the ATM enclosure was not provided. The Credit Union is seeking approval of the specific plans for this ATM enclosure.)

5. Final PUD Plat: Rohrman Property south side of Grand Avenue and east of Menards

(The subject property consists of approximately 10 acres located south of Grand Avenue and east of Menards. The subject property is zoned C/B-2 PUD and has Preliminary PUD Plat approval for 2 automobile dealerships; Volkswagen and Hyundai. Final PUD Plat approval is requested.)

6. Public Hearing: Request by Mr. Rodis for an Amendment to an existing Special Use Permit for Riverside Plaza Signage

(The subject property is located at the northeast corner of Rt. 21 and Washington Street (401 N. Route 21) and is commonly known as Riverside Plaza. The property is zoned C/B-2, Community Business District. The petitioner is requesting an amendment to a Special Use Permit secured in 1990, which allows signage for the property to exceed the maximum permitted under the C/B/-2 zoning district.)
