
Not a vigilante group or mentality

There are no citizen patrols


Provides no shield for citizens to act on their own





### Questions and Discussion













- Slow down and pull over safely as soon as possible.
- An officer may approach your vehicle from the passenger or driver side.
- Stay in the driver's seat with both hands clearly in sight on the steering wheel.
- Do not exit your vehicle unless asked to do so.
- Turn on your interior light if stopped at night.













Being Pulled Over by Law Enforcement

- Comply with the officer's request to see your driver's license and proof of insurance.
- If these items are in the glove box, under the seat or if your proof of insurance is stored for display on your cellphone, inform the officer of that fact and then follow his/her directions before retrieving them.
- If you are issued a ticket requiring a signature, sign it. Signing a ticket is not an admission of guilt only an acknowledgment of receiving the ticket.

Being Pulled Over by Law Enforcement

- If you are suspected of drunk driving, cooperate with the officer(s) on the scene. If you refuse to submit to breath, blood or performance tests, your refusal could result in loss of driving privileges.
- Be aware that you may have committed some minor traffic violation without realizing it, there may be some problem with your vehicle of which you are unaware or you might be driving a vehicle that is similar to one used in a serious crime.









## Being Pulled Over by Law Enforcement



- Cooperate even if you believe you have not committed an offense.
- If you believe you have been treated unfairly, present your case in traffic court and not to the officer along the roadway.
- You are to be treated with dignity and respect by the officer.
- If you believe that an officer has acted inappropriately during a traffic stop or other encounter, you should report that conduct ASAP to the officer's superiors.
