Police Activity Summary:

Greystone (57-2):

179 police calls for service were generated during the first half of 2017 in the patrol beat. 9 of those calls were for actual crimes. The rest of the police calls are considered quasi-criminal, traffic, and service-related.

Elysian Fields and Concord (58-2):

500 police calls for service were generated during the first half of 2017 in the patrol beat. 30 of those calls were for actual crimes. The rest of the police calls are considered quasi-criminal, traffic, and service-related.

Ravinia Woods (71-2):

97 police calls for service were generated during the first half of 2017 in the patrol beat. 6 of those calls were for actual crimes. The rest of the police calls are considered quasi-criminal, traffic, and service-related.

Bittersweet Woods (72-2):

186 police calls for service were generated during the first half of 2017 in the patrol beat. 5 of those calls were for actual crimes. The rest of the police calls are considered quasi-criminal, traffic, and service-related.

After reviewing the crime and police activity update Officers Snyder and Bendler gave a presentation entitled "Being Pulled Over by Law Enforcement."
