Grand Ave., Gurnee, IL Mariano's 6655 Grand Ave., Gurnee, IL</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clean and empty plastic bags should be stuffed into one bag and tied closed then recycled at a participating retailer. • DO NOT place plastic bags in your recycling container. • Additionally, Gurnee's Walmart, Kohl's, Target and Home Depot also accept plastic bags and wrap.
	<p>Polystyrene Styrofoam</p>	<p>Highland Park's Recycling Center 1180 Half Day Rd., Highland Park, IL Every Tuesday & Every 1st Saturday of the Month, 7am - 1pm</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only clean, dry and #6 labeled polystyrene products will be accepted. • If you have LRS as your recycling hauler, styrofoam can be recycled through the Hefty ReNew Orange Bag Program. 	<p>Sharps</p>	<p>Must Be in Rigid Plastic Container Before Disposing in Regular Trash</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The sharps disposal kiosk is no longer available at the Gurnee Village Hall due to patron misuse. • Residents may put sharps in a sturdy plastic container such as a sharps container, detergent bottle or milk jug and dispose of it in the regular trash.
	<p>Shoes</p>	<p>Gurnee Public Works Facility 1151 Kilbourne Rd., Gurnee, IL Open 365 Days, 24/7</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All types, sizes and brands are accepted. • NOT ACCEPTED Items: Ice skates, rollerblades, winter boots, moldy shoes or badly damaged shoes in pieces/missing soles. • If a pair, please keep shoes paired by tying, banding or bagging them together.
