Moon Development, Inc. and The Burton Foundation are requesting the following items: 1) Zoning Map Amendment to rezone approximate 6.6 acres from E-Estate District in unincorporated Lake County to R-1, Single Family Residential District in the Village of Gurnee; 2) Special Use Permit for a Preliminary Planned Unit Development application to develop the subject property with a 4-story Supportive Living Facility (SLF) for physically disabled adults, including certain departures from the Village's codes, ordinances, rules and regulations; 3) Special Use Permit to allow a Supportive Living Facility (SLF) for physically disabled adults, more formally defined within the Zoning Ordinance as a Geriatric Center/Institution for the Care of the Aged; 4) Special Use Permit to allow internal horizontal light levels to exceed 14.99 footcandles associated with an entrance canopy; and 5) Such other relief as may be necessary to accomplish the applicant's development plan.

The subject property is zoned E-Estate District in unincorporated Lake County and is located at 16256-16346 Washington Street, which is on the north side of Washington Street, approximately 700 feet from the Washington Street and Cemetery Road intersection.
