(Great Northern Resorts, LLC, is requesting an amendment to a Planned Unit Development and certain special uses for the 20-acre parcel commonly known as the Auto Nation site located generally south of the Commonwealth Edison right-of-way, west of Nations Drive, north of Grand Avenue and east of the Illinois Tollway (I-94). Preliminary PUD Plat approval is also requested. One application is for an amendment to the provisions of the existing Planned Unit Development affecting Lot 1 to allow modifications to (a) the maximum permitted height of hotel/motel buildings; (b) the maximum permitted floor area ratio; (c) signage standards; and (d) inclusion of amusement establishments as a special use in the underlying C/O-2 zoning designation. Additional applications are for special uses for outdoor seating areas in conjunction with restaurants, an outdoor swimming pool, a water park amusement establishment and an arcade. The Plan Commission may also consider such other relief as may be necessary or desirable in connection with the applications.)
