3. Final Plat: JSL Re-Subdivision

Ms. Einspanjer explained that this 3 lot final plat is located at the northeast corner of Belle Plaine and Grove Avenue. The property is zoned R-3 and contains 29,864 sq. ft. The owners have received variances to the minimum lot size, minimum lot with and rear yard setback for the existing house. The final plat is in general conformance with the Subdivision Ordinance and is recommended for approval subject to final engineering approval.

Mr. Kaplan moved; seconded by Mr. Hellstern, to approve the Final Plat for JSL Re-Subdivision subject to final engineering.

4. Final Plat: Villas of Stonebrook Phase IIA

Ms. Einspanjer explained that the subject property is zoned R-5 PUD and contains approximately 15 acres. The property is located south of Grand Avenue and west of Stonebrook Drive (Bailey property). The final plat includes 4 townhome/villa buildings containing 6 units each and 4 coach home buildings containing 4 units each. A total of 40 units is included in this final plat.

Mr. Nate Wynsma, Westfield Homes, stated that there were several minor modifications to this final plat from the approved preliminary plat. These changes include:

- 1. The private road into the coach home area was flipped to the west side of the buildings in order to provide the buildings with rear yard views of Spruce Lake.
- 2. The trail that was to pass adjacent to the private road in the coach home area was eliminated due to its close proximity to the buildings.

Mr. Cepon moved, seconded by Mr. Gill, to approve the Final Plat for the Villas of Stonebrook Phase IIA.
