The property is zoned C/B-2 PUD (Community Business as a Planned Unit Development). The petitioner is requesting Preliminary PUD Plat approval for the entire 20 acre parcel and approval of two (2) Special Use Permits to allow the establishment and operation of two car dealerships; one on approximately a 6 acre portion of the site and one on approximately a 5 acre portion of the site.)
