The subject property is zoned C/B-2-PUD, Community Business District as a PUD (approximately 5.96 acres) & E – Estate in Unincorporated Lake County (approximately 1.7 acres).)

5. Final PUD Plat: NorthShore University HealthSystem Medical Office Building

(NorthShore University HealthSystem is requesting Final PUD Plat approval to allow a 2-story, approximately 66,000 square foot medical office building at the southwest corner of Grand Avenue (Route 132) and Rollins Road and contains approximately 7.6 total acres of property.)

6. Final Subdivision Plat: NorthShore University HealthSystem

(NorthShore University HealthSystem is requesting Final Subdivision Plat approval as part of their proposed development plans in order to create a subdivision consisting of a 7.4 acre lot and a 0.2 acre lot located at the southwest corner of Grand Avenue (Route 132) and Rollins Road. The subject property is zoned C/B-2-PUD, Community Business District as a PUD (approximately 5.96 acres) & E – Estate in Unincorporated Lake County (approximately 1.7 acres))

## 7. Public Hearing: Thomas Place Senior Living Facility & Hunt Club Development Rezoning

A. Thomas Place Senior Living Facility

(Ryan Companies, US, Inc., is requesting the following applications:

- Rezoning from R-2 PUD Single-Family Residence District to R-5 PUD Limited Multi-Family District;
- ii. Special Use for a Preliminary Planned Unit Development; and
- iii. Such other relief as may be necessary to accomplish the applicant's development plan. The purpose of the application is to allow a 4-story, 116 unit Independent Senior Living Facility located on the east side of Hunt Club Road approximately 600 feet north of Washington Street. The subject property is zoned R-2 PUD Single-Family Residence District as a PUD (formerly Courts of Hunt Club) and contains approximately 12 acres.)
- B. Hunt Club Development Rezoning

(Hunt Club Development, LLC, is requesting approval of an application for rezoning from R-2 PUD Single-Family Residence District to R-2 Single-Family Residence District. The proposal does not have development plans proposal and will effectively eliminate the previously approved Courts of Hunt Club residential development. The subject property is located on the

East side of Hunt Club Road approximately 700 feet north of Washington Street and north of the proposed Thomas Place Senior Independent Living Facility. The subject property is zoned R-2 PUD— Single Family Residence District as a PUD and is governed by an Annexation Agreement.)
