## Treasurer's Report

Period Ending July 31, 2018

Gosnell outlined included is the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter. There is 1 pending reimbursement request from Gurnee. On the revenue side is \$304,048.34, which is ahead of budget. The April payment was late and fell into this fiscal year and the June disbursement included unspent grant reimbursement money. The ending balance is \$840,834.43, prior to the Gurnee pending reimbursement. The only thing outstanding is a transfer to Zion for last years final reimbursement request. This is pending some information from Zion. This leaves the final balance of \$872,412.52.

Chairman Velkover thanked Gosnell for his work in preparing that report.

#### **Communications Statistics**

June 2018 July 2018

Brunell stated June was normal but between the month of June and July a significant increase was seen over a 2 week period. This was over the 4th of July time frame. There is no particular reason for the increase. After the end of the month we will be able to begin a month by month comparison of before and after consolidation.

#### **Gurnee - Zion ETSB and PSAP Consolidation**

Winthrop Harbor Backup Agreement

Velkover thanked Phil Brunell and Chief Woodside for sending out a letter advising that it was our intent to no longer be their backup post consolidation on their end.

## Non-Emergency lines from Zion PD

Velkover had asked about the issue that occurred with the non-emergency lines about 2 weeks ago and asked if details were known as to the root cause. AT&T was contacted and advised it was not their issue. Henderson advised Midco was contacted and they did some type of remote reset which fixed the issue. There was also discussion about not having circuit numbers for those lines. That information is now available for communications staff in case an issue arises again off hours. Henderson advised that a phone call to AT&T should be first, then a call to himself and/or the Chief.

#### 2017 Consolidation Grant

Consolidation Grant - Periodic Performance Report

Velkover advised we ended up at just under 90% of the total award amount. We had a combination of a few items that were under the estimate and few items that were still in progress at the end of the grant period. Brunell advised we spent \$487,456.33, leaving \$66,711.67. Both Brunell and Gosnell advised we did very well with the time frame we had.

#### 9-1-1 Answering Equipment & Trunks

9-1-1 Network Costs – AT&T / Illinois State Police & Call Volume Study

There are no changes in the monthly billed amounts and there is nothing new to report for the call volume study.

## **CAD System**

Superion, Tritech, and Apteans public sector businesses will merge.

Notification was made that the 3 businesses would be merging to become 1 larger company with combined resources.

#### **Radio Systems**

Quad 1 & Gurnee Fire Radio System Implementation & Zion Police Station Radio Gateway

An equipment cabinet was delivered to the Beach Park Water tower, equipment to follow at a later date. Voter equipment was delivered and not installed yet. JPS voter recordings continue to be collected.

## **PSAP Metropolitan Area Network**

Point to Point Microwave Network & Intergovernmental Agreement Beach Park Water Tower Current has made notification that all the equipment is in and they are looking to schedule the field work for that. The IG was approved by both Gurnee and Beach Park.

#### **Lake County Regional Consolidation Committee**

Regional 911 Policy Committee Agenda 08-02-2018

Velkover advised there are 2 groups, a policy and an operations group. After a few iterations of who was going to sit where it is close to having that sorted. On the operations side Velkover and Chief Kavanagh are sitting and back-ups for each other. On the policy side Muetz from the Village, from the JETSB side it was a question as to whether Chief Lewis or Chief Woodside would be the primary and alternate. It was decided Lewis will be the primary and Woodside will be the alternate, with Woodside being the alternate for Muetz as well.

## First Draft IGA Regarding Regional 911 Consolidation

Kavanagh advised from today's email the IGA has changed and they have received some general notes on it. There is a meeting with the States Attorney on it trying to pull some language out of it.

Technology Working Group Meeting – July 18, 2018

Velkover advised he attended this and they had a good, solid discussion. Emphasis was on standardized data collection, GIS data standardizing and the County looking into a new CAD system.

# Consideration of Reimbursement Request 2019-01-Village of Gurnee - May 1 - July 31, 2018

Details were included in the packet and the total is \$169,955.62. This includes the \$30,000.00 for the county group and 50% of the radio and microwave equipment.

## Consideration of Proposals / Expenditures / Invoices / Bills

Nationwide Power UPS Service Agreement - \$2,863.00

Velkover highlighted a proposed change in service provider for UPS equipment. The manufacturer has announced the end of life for the existing agreements so 3<sup>rd</sup> party providers were looked at. John Petersen did work on that and the proposal is about 1/3 of the manufacturers cost. They received good recommendations and this would be a 50/50 split with the police department.

Invoice – ComLabs – EMnet Standalone Receiver - \$512.26

This will replace the current setup that is currently running an unsupported version of Windows (XP).

Invoice – CDS Office Technology – Sierra Wireless Routers - \$4,676.00 Gurnee PD squad change out equipment for the new squads being put in place.
