## 2022 Illinois ETSA Draft Legislation & Comments – 09/19/2022

Consolidation Options being discussed -

County's Serving a Population > 100,000 where additional PSAP's serve a population < 50,000 Consolidate/Regionalize within two years of the date of the passage of the ETSA.

If consolidated previously complete further consolidation within 3 years.

Municipal/Intergovernmental Systems < 75,000 Consolidate/Regionalize within 2 Years from the date of passage of the ETSA (< 50,000?)
