The above neighborhoods had their most recent neighborhood watch meeting on 09/11/19. The meeting was facilitated by Officers Nauseda and Tazzioli.

Police Activity Summary:

234 police calls for service were generated during January 1 - June 30, 2019 in this area. In the Steeple Pointe/Churhill-Hunt area, 2 calls related to actual crimes occurred. Coventry Estates also recorded 2 calls for actual crimes. The rest of the police calls are considered quasi-criminal, traffic, and service-related.

Crime Prevention:

Officer Nauseda led a discussion about the cannabis law that will go into effect on January 1, 2020 and the impact it may have in our Village. The Village Board is also considering the option to allow a recreational dispensary in town, based on the guidelines of the new law. Residents were encourage to visit the Village of Gurnee website to take a short survey to express their opinion on the topic.
