## **Police Activity Summary for Single-family Home Area of Patrol Beat 80 (west of Delany Rd.):**

22 police calls for service were responded to in the Brown Circle neighborhood during the first half of 2018. 1 of the calls for service were for actual crimes. The rest of the police calls are considered quasi-criminal, traffic, and service-related.

## **Police Activity Summary for Patrol Beat 81 (east of Delany Rd.):**

945 police calls for service were responded to in patrol beat 81 during the first half of 2018. 37 of the calls for service were for actual crimes. The rest of the police calls are considered quasi-criminal, traffic, and service-related.

## **Crime Prevention:**

After reviewing the crime and police activity update, Officers led a discussion and question-answer period covering 10 principles of crime prevention.
