## **Aggravated Battery Investigation**

**Gurnee** – On October 5, 2020, at approximately 5:50 PM, Gurnee officers responded to the area of Dilleys Road and Nations Drive in reference to a gunshot victim. Officers immediately responded and located a juvenile male with a gunshot wound to the leg. The Gurnee Fire Department assisted with medical treatment and transported the victim to Advocate Condell Medical Center. The victim's injuries are not considered life-threatening.

The preliminary investigation revealed the victim had a pre-arranged meeting with acquaintances in a parking lot near the intersection of Stearns School Road and Dilleys Road. An altercation erupted, and the acquaintances fired shots at the victim, striking him in the leg. The victim drove a few blocks away from the scene before calling the police for assistance.

Gurnee officers searched the area and conducted a track with K9 Hunter. The offenders left the scene before police arrived, and the incident appears to be an isolated occurrence.

Investigators are actively working this case, and any residents or businesses in the nearby area with exterior surveillance cameras are encouraged to contact the Gurnee Police Department.
