Serious Traffic Crash in Gurnee

Gurnee – On February 27, 2022, at approximately 1:40 PM, Gurnee Police responded to the area of Washington Street and Greenleaf Street for a vehicle crash with injuries. Officers located a 2019 black Dodge Durango and a 2008 silver Chevrolet HHR with extensive damage.

Based on the initial investigation, the driver of the Dodge was traveling eastbound on Washington Street, approaching the intersection of Greenleaf Street. The Chevrolet was traveling westbound on Washington Street, attempting to turn south onto Greenleaf Street. The Chevrolet turned left through the intersection and collided head-on with the Dodge. The driver and sole occupant of the Chevrolet, a 62-year-old female from Waukegan, sustained serious injuries and received life-saving measures by Gurnee Fire Department paramedics at the scene. She was transported to Advocate Condell Medical Center for further treatment. She remains in the hospital.

The two occupants of the Dodge, a 34-year-old female and a 37-year-old male, both from Round Lake, were transported to Vista Medical Center for minor injuries.

The intersection remained closed for approximately three hours while investigators with the Major Crash Assistance Team (MCAT) assisted with the crash investigation. This crash remains under investigation by the Gurnee Police Department.
